- Level 5 in Pure Mathematics for Grade 11 results
- Level 6 average for Grade 11 results (excluding Life Orientation)
- Completion of the National Benchmark Test by 30 September 2017
- You cannot be older than 21 years of age in the year of

Requirements for 1st Year University Students (Deadline is 17 August 2017)

- Citizens of South Africa
- Belief in the future of your country
- An ambassador of the Foundation's intended profile (see General Selection Criteria above)
- Studying towards a degree in Commerce, Science (excluding Medicine), Humanities (majoring Politics, Philosophy or Economics), Engineering or Law
- Studying at the following universities WITS, UJ, UCT, NMMU, Rhodes, UWC, Stellenbosch, TSiBA, UFS or UP
- Minimum average of 65% for your 2016 mid-year (June) exam results
- You cannot be older than 22 years of age in the year of your application
